

The original volumes contain corrections and queries written at various times from different sources as they became available. In the first few volumes the corrections come from the *Journal for the Preservation of Memorials of the Dead* (JMD) while for Wexford they tend to come from Parish Histories, etc. BJC had no strict policy for dealing with later transcriptions by others and always recommended that additions and corrections should be published independently. These addenda generally do not appear in copies held by libraries and archives. The following is a complete set of addenda, since the original scans may not be clear or legible as some of the entries are written lightly in pencil.
